CATS September Meeting

committee. Please note that although anyone can attend this part of the meeting, only fully-paid up CATS members can bid in the auction for items from the CATS Asset List. All payments must be in cash on the evening. Cheques will not be accepted. There will be no commission on any monies paid.

After the conclusion of the auction of items from the CATS Asset List, there will be an auction of any other items of spare, genuine radio equipment that CATS members wish to have auctioned on their behalf. So if you have any useful pieces of kit that you wish to dispose of, please bring it/them along on the Monday evening. Again there will be no commission on any monies paid. In this part of the meeting, non-members will be eligible to bid if they wish.

The committee look forward to seeing as many members as possible on this evening. We are also expecting one or more potential new members to attend for the first time.
